Certificate I in Work Education

Explore your employment and training options with our specialist developed program. If you have a permanent cognitive impairment or intellectual disability and need support with your learning and goal setting then our Certificate I in Work Education is the course for you.

About the course

The focus of this course is to enable students with special learning needs to gain independence and community awareness. Students will gain an understanding of educational pathways and improve their employability skills.

The Certificate I in Work Education will provide students with a range of practical experiences. It will give students an understanding of basic workplace expectations and prepare them to enter the workforce.

Course structure

This course is made up of 10 units of competency including 7 core and 3 elective units.

Elective units in our courses may be amended for specific organisational needs. Consultation with the Education and Training Manager is required for tailored electives that align with your organisations requirements.

Course duration

This model is delivered over a 50 week period.

Classroom model - Training is delivered 2 days a week (excluding public holidays and school holidays).

Entry requirements

Entry to this course is restricted to post compulsory school age learners with evidence of a permanent cognitive impairment or intellectual disability.

Permanent cognitive impairment or intellectual disability must be evidenced. Evidence could include but is not limited to:

- Formal assessment by a registered medical practitioner, doctor, or specialist.
- Attendance at a Special School / SDS Integration support at school.
- Integration support at school with modified curriculum.

Practical placement

Students will participate in 2 to 6 vocational activities.

*You will need to undergo a National Police Check before you begin the practical placement. Practical placement may not be possible if a check that is carried out contains adverse outcomes. In this instance, you may not be able to complete your qualification and your employment opportunities may be affected. If you are aware of, or are concerned about anything that may appear on a Police Check, please discuss this at your enrolment interview.

Course fees

Course fees are outlined on our website.

For additional service fees, such as re-assessment fees or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), please refer to the Student Course Guide. This program is delivered with Victorian and Commonwealth Government funding to eligible candidates.

Outcome

Students obtaining a 'Competent' result for all units studied will be issued a 'Certificate' – 22566VIC Certificate I in Work Education issued by BRACE. Should a student not complete the full course, a 'Statement of Attainment' will be issued for the units which the student is deemed 'Competent'.
